

Insurance Inspection Boot Camp FAQ

Why consider doing an insurance inspection?

We've found that many real estate professionals like insurance inspection work for the following reasons:

- There is no value involved. There is no pressure to determine value or marketability.
- The turn times are low pressure. The report should be submitted to Pro-Teck within 2 weeks after it is assigned. It's perfect filler work.
- Orders tend to be concentrated. Sometimes there are 30-40 orders in the same town. This not a rule, but it is not uncommon.

How much money can I expect to make?

- You can average \$30/hour; Interiors generally pay \$25 and Exteriors \$15. The scope of the inspection is limited, only requiring 5-15 minutes on site. Most inspectors find that they can complete an average of 10 inspections per day.

What are Pro-Teck's expectations?

- Communication and quality are paramount.
- We expect you to attempt to make contact with homeowners within 24 hours of receiving new work.
- We expect you to contact us when something comes up that will prevent your completing work on time.
- All of your work should be a source of pride and done with excellence.
